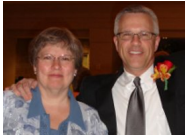


Senior Pastor

Scott Kliewer grew up in Topeka, KS, which is about two hours from Newton. He was blessed to have grown up in a Christian home and realized his need of salvation as a young boy. Church was always a very important part of his childhood, with his parents being very involved in local church ministry.

Through a series of events, God provided a door of opportunity for him to attend Silver State Baptist High School in Denver, CO, a school affiliated with what was then called South Sheridan Baptist Church, pastored by Dr. Ed Nelson. He was active in various aspects of the ministry, including a church bus route to reach inner city children and was afforded various opportunities to preach to other teens in the Youth Department. It was there, during his senior year, that God used the influence of the church and school to call him into the ministry.

In the fall of 1975, he enrolled at Bob Jones University in Greenville, SC as a Bible major, with a minor in History. God began opening opportunities for ministry, both at college and during the summers.

the Senior Pastor. He assumed that position in April 2008.
